

Alexander Gershman, M.D.

Dr. Alexander Gershman graduated with honors from Moscow Medical School in Moscow, Russia in 1984. He received his Ph.D. in Urology from the Moscow Institute of Urology, Moscow, Russia.

He was invited to Cedar Sinai Medical Center as a visiting professor to develop the program of Minimally Invasive Urologic Surgery. He then completed a six year residency program at UCLA Medical Center in Urologic Surgery, followed by a Fellowship in Laparoscopic Surgery at the Division of Urology, UCLA Medical Center. He became board certified with the American Board of Urology in February 2001.

Dr. Gershman is currently in private practice in Beverly Hills. He holds two academic appointments: Chief of Laparoscopic Surgery at Harbor UCLA Medical Center and Head of the Endourology Division of Greater Los Angeles Veteran Administration Health Care System. He is also the Director of Urologic Services at Midway Medical Center, and Chief of Laparoscopic Kidney Transplant Surgery at ST. Mary's Hospital in Long Beach.

Dr. Gershman has provided badly needed services to Russian physicians and patients both in Los Angeles and in Russia. He currently is president of the American Russian Medical Association.
